

Historic New England Otis House Museum Group Tour Information

Hours of Operation

- Year-round, Wednesday through Sunday, 11:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- *Magnificent and Modest: Beacon Hill Walking Tour* is also available for groups.
- Group tours, including walking tours, may be scheduled when the museum is closed, depending on availability. Walking tours may be scheduled year-round, weather permitting.

Tour Length

- Approximately one hour. Please allow 1½ hours for planning purposes. Tour length can be customized.
- Please remember that the Otis House Museum may be open to the public when your group arrives. Groups arriving late may receive a tour only for the remaining reserved time.

Costs

- Group tour rate is \$7 per adult and \$4 per student. Group rate available for groups of 8 or more.
- Group rate for *Magnificent and Modest* walking tour is \$12 per adult and \$8 per student.
- Tour leaders, class instructors, bus drivers admitted free.

Parking

- Street parking and several paid lots are available near the Otis House. Buses can pick up and drop off on Cambridge Street but must park elsewhere.

Accessibility

- A tour of the Otis House Museum requires a considerable amount of standing and walking. A limited number of folding chairs are provided if necessary. The first floor can be made accessible with a portable ramp. The second floor is accessible only by a flight of stairs. Please notify staff in advance if your group requires additional accommodations.

Museum Shop

- Offers an assortment of books, postcards, souvenirs, and gift items. Please allow additional time after your tour if your group would like to browse the shop. Please inquire about specials offered for our group tour guests.

Facilities

- The Otis House Museum has one restroom. The restroom is down one flight of stairs from the museum level. A handicapped accessible route can be made available with advance notice.
- Soft drinks and bottled water are available in limited quantities. No food is sold at the Otis House.

Neighborhood

- The Otis House Museum is located in downtown Boston, at the foot of Beacon Hill. A wide variety of restaurants, shops, and attractions are nearby.

We Respectfully Ask that you Remember:

- Food and drink are prohibited in the museum.
- Cameras or recording devices are prohibited in the museum.
- Pencils, not pens, may be used to take notes in the museum.
- Touching, leaning, or sitting on the objects is prohibited.
- Cell phones should be turned off prior to your tour.
- Your group will stay with the tour guide for the entire tour.
