My share of the harvest will be protected by sound farming practices and will be certified organic. I am entitled to a weekly portion of the farm's harvest and agree to work on or for the farm during the season. I understand if I fail to pick up my share during the pick-up hours, I forfeit that week's share.

### About Casey Farm

This 300-acre working farm overlooking Narragansett Bay was a prosperous plantation in the mid-eighteenth century. Five generations of the Casey family made improvements and farmed the land with the aid of tenant farmers. Today, the farm offers a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) Program featuring organically grown vegetables, herbs, and flowers. Tours include the farmyard and cemetery, and visitors are encouraged to explore the farm's hiking trails.

### Schedule and Admissions

Open for tours on Saturdays, 9 AM-2 PM, June 1 through October 15. Admission is \$4 adults, \$3 senior citizens, \$2 children 6 through 12. Free admission for Historic New England members. *The Farmer's Market runs Saturday, 9 AM - noon, May 17 - November 1.* Note: Historic New England's Watson Farm is less than 5 miles away; call 401-423-0005 for hours and directions.

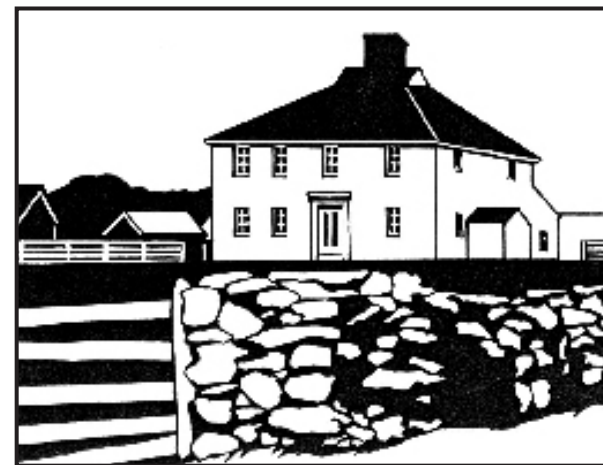
### Membership in Historic New England

## Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)

Members of Casey Farm's CSA receive a mix of fresh organic vegetables, fruits, and herbs weekly over the twenty-one week season. Most items are harvested the day you receive them, assuring peak flavor and nutrition.

All CSA members work for the farm, both to reduce the need for hired help and to give members a sense of what is involved in food production. The **eight hours** of work during the season may include planting, cultivating, or harvesting.

This year we are offering "worker shares," which allow you to work four hours weekly in exchange for a single share. Please call us for more information on this share option.

### Share options:

Full Share (feeds 3 to 6 people)

- between 10 and 30 pounds of produce a week for 21 weeks
- \$730 per season (\$35 per week)

Single Share (feeds 1 to 3 people)

- between 6 and 20 pounds of produce a week for 21 weeks
- \$465 per season (\$22 per week)

### Shares include:

- once-a-week distribution of fresh produce
- pick-your-own produce and flowers
- opportunity to buy cheese, maple syrup, and produce from area farms
- newsletters throughout the season
- Historic New England membership



## A sample of what produce to expect

### In June a single share may get in a week:

- pick-your-own strawberries
- 1 or 2 heads of lettuce
- mixed greens (e.g. spinach, arugula, chard)
- 2 pounds of carrots, beets, or radishes
- 1 to 2 pounds of broccoli
- choice of chives, oregano, sorrel, or dill
- 6-stem bouquet of flowers

### In September a single share may get in a week:

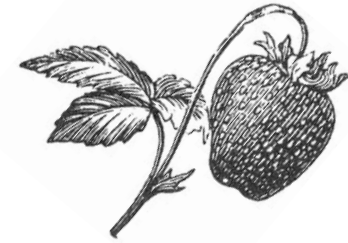
- pick-your-own cherry tomatoes and green beans
- 1 pound of salad greens
- 6 pounds your choice of celery, peppers, eggplant, onions, fennel, or carrots
- 15 tomatoes
- 3 heads of garlic
- choice of basil, thyme, or parsley
- 12-stem bouquet of flowers
